Rogers emphasized that Bose brings the unique combination of vision and execution needed to seize the immense opportunity surrounding human and AI teamwork. "Arnab thinks beyond features to building a multi-product platform that serves users across the enterprise and unlocks new industries. His experience building enterprise products during major technology waves—from on-premises to cloud, desktop to mobile, and now AI—gives him the right perspective and skills to help us achieve our goals."

"My career began by helping drive the shift to the cloud, which gave me a deep understanding of how to lead during periods of monumental change," said Bose. "I believe an even larger transformation is coming in how humans collaborate with AI. Asana is uniquely positioned to lead this change, and I'm excited to build products that have the context needed to unlock the next level of human + AI collaboration."

Prior to Okta, Bose held product leadership roles at Salesforce and Microsoft. Throughout his career, Bose has built enterprise products that have reached billions of users and holds more than 15 patents.
